The regular called meeting of the City Council of the City of Bay Minette was held December 4, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall in Bay Minette, Alabama; this being the proper place, date and hour for holding such meeting.

On roll call, the following members of Council were found to be present: Mayor Robert A. Wills; Councilmember Danleigh Corbett; Councilmember Mike Phillips; Councilmember John Biggs; and Councilmember; William Taylor; and Councilmember Shannon Clemmons. Mayor Wills called the meeting to order and Councilmember Taylor gave the invocation. Councilmember Phillips led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve the consent agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Corbett and unanimously carried.

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve Resolution Number 1217-01 NBU Sale of Surplus Property. Councilmember Biggs moved to approve the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Taylor and unanimously carried.

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve a contract between the City of Bay Minette and Cintas subject to legal counsel. Councilmember Biggs moved to approve the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Clemmons and unanimously carried.
