THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAY MINETTE, ALABAMA AS HELD APRIL 1, 2019

The regular called meeting of the City Council of the City of Bay Minette was held on April 1, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall in Bay Minette, Alabama; this being the proper place, scheduled date and hour for holding such meeting.

On roll call, the following members of Council were found to be present: Mayor Robert A. Wills; Councilmember Danleigh Corbett; Councilmember Mike Phillips; Councilmember John Biggs; Councilmember William Taylor and Councilmember Shannon Clemmons. Others in regular attendance Scotty Lewis, Attorney; Tammy Smith, Administrator/Finance Director; Rita Diedtrich, City Clerk; Tina Covington, Community Relations; Marlee Bailey, North Baldwin Chamber of Commerce; and Jason Padgett, North Baldwin Utilities.

Mayor Wills called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. Councilmember Phillips led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Wills recognized Braiden Williams, from the Baldwin County High School Wrestling Team who place as the State Runner-up.

Consent Agenda

Councilmember Biggs moved to approve the resolution. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Clemmons and unanimously carried.

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve Resolution Number 0419-02 Kid's Park Rental Fee Waiver for the Bay Minette Lion's Club to hold a Walk for Diabetes Awareness Fundraiser and Education on May 18, 2019. Councilmember Clemmons moved to approve the resolution. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Taylor and unanimously carried.

Mayor Wills asked if anyone would like to address the Council. Mr. Richard King who lives at 7th Street and Moog Avenue addressed the removal of the four-way stop sign and the installation of a two-way stop sign. Mr. King requested the four-way stop sign be re-installed.
