The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Bay Minette was held on August 2, 2021 at 6 p.m. at the City Hall in Bay Minette, Alabama; this being the proper place, scheduled date and hour for holding such meeting.

On roll call, the following members of the Council were found to be present: Mayor Robert A. Mayor Wills called the meeting to order, and Councilmember Taylor gave the invocation. Councilmember Sellers led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda
